The lanterns, which feature a blown-glass light dome, represent the duo's continued experimentation with leather weaving—this time in a honeycomb-pattern cage. When illuminated with a rechargeable LED light, the pieces, featuring details inspired by Louis Vuitton handbags, cast delicate shadows as they softly
